WORKING TOGETHER TO SAVE LIVES

Penn Township Ambulance assisted other community ambulance services **117** times last year.

Because it is impossible to respond to every request for ambulance service, Penn Township Ambulance deploys a neighboring EMS unit into our service area to provide temporary coverage until one of our units are available. **165** times last year a neighboring agency responded in our place.



Penn Township Ambulance logged **56,972** miles on its vehicles. This is an increase of 2% from 2021. This year our fleet used a total of **6,859** gallons of fuel. This a 1% increase due to the increase in emergency responses.

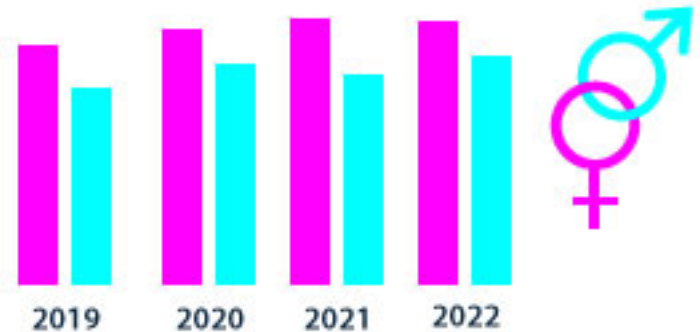
Last year Penn Township Ambulance treated 2,395 patients. Of those patients 797 were between the age of 21 and 64. This accounts for 33% of all patients treated.
